



NOTICE OF UNSOLICITED PROPOSAL ACCEPTANCE

BEDFORD REGIONAL WATER AUTHORITY, BEDFORD COUNTY, VIRGINIA

In accordance with the Public Private Educational Facilities and Infrastructure Act of 2002 ("PPEA"), the Bedford Regional Water Authority (the "Authority") has received a proposal for review from Garney Companies, Inc. for the design and construction of the Ivy Creek Interceptor and construction of the Route 460 Pump Station. The Ivy Creek Interceptor being a sewer extension from the Forest service area to the City of Lynchburg to provide expanded public wastewater service through a gravity interceptor as defined in a preliminary engineering report entitled '[Ivy Creek Interceptor Divisions 5 and 6 PER](#)' and dated February 10, 2020. The Route 460 Pump Station being a water booster station designed for construction on East Crest Drive in Bedford, Virginia to transmit flow between the Lakes, Forest, and Central water service areas.

The Authority intends to evaluate the proposal, may negotiate a comprehensive agreement with the proposer based on the proposal, and will accept for simultaneous consideration any competing proposals that comply with the [procedures](#) adopted by the Authority and the provisions of the PPEA.

In order to be considered, all proposals must be submitted in a sealed envelope/package and received in the Authority office no later than 4:00 p.m. (local prevailing time) on **Tuesday, July 7, 2020**.
