### **INVITATION FOR BIDS**

Sealed bids for the construction of the Town & Country Sewer Replacement project will be received by the Bedford Regional Water Authority (BRWA) at the Bedford Regional Water Authority's Office, 1723 Falling Creek Road, Bedford, Virginia 24523 until **2:00 PM**, local prevailing time on **Wednesday, August 24, 2022**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

### **CONTRACT DESCRIPTION**

This project consists of the replacement of deteriorating sanitary sewer lines within the Town and Country subdivision. Approximately 9,000 lf of sanitary sewer lines with associated appurtenances will be replaced.

### **PRE-BID CONFERENCE, CLARIFICATIONS, AND ADDENDA**

A pre-bid conference will not be held for this project due to BRWA offices being closed to the public amidst the COVID-19 Pandemic. Deadline for questions and clarifications on the contract documents must be made in writing by 5:00 PM on **Friday, August 12, 2022**. Only clarifications by formal written addenda will be binding. Contract is to be awarded on a unit price basis.

**CONTRACT LICENSING**

Bidder’s attention is invited to the requirements of Title 54.1, Chapter 11, of the Code of Virginia pertaining to registration which specifies the following:

“Class A contractors” perform or manage construction, removal, repair, or improvements when (i) the total value referred to in a single contract or project is \$120,000 or more, or (ii) the total value of all such construction, removal, repair, or improvements undertaken by such person within any 12-month period is \$750,000 or more.

“Class B contractors” perform or manage construction, removal, repair, or improvements when (i) the total value referred to in a single contract or project is \$10,000 or more, but less than \$120,000, or (ii) the total value of all such construction, removal, repair or improvements undertaken by such person within any 12-month period is \$150,000 or more, but less than \$750,000.

The bidder shall place on the outside of the envelope containing the bid and shall place in the bid over his signature whichever of the following notations is appropriate:

“Licensed Class A Virginia Contractor No. \_\_\_\_\_.”

“Licensed Class B Virginia Contractor No. \_\_\_\_\_.”

**NONDISCRIMINATION AND DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE**
