Bedford Regional Water Authority to Host Community Meeting in Montvale

BRWA to Assume Just Under 300 Montvale Water Customers

At the request of Montvale Water and with the support of the Virginia Department of Health, the BRWA is assuming water service to the current customers of Montvale Water. The BRWA has provided sewer services to the Montvale community for some time and started offering maintenance and water operations support to the residents in late June. Upon signing of the final agreement by Montvale Water and approval by the State Corporation Commission, the BRWA will assume full water operations for the community in the coming months.

“Due to the sewer service we’ve provided to the Montvale community for years, the assumption of water operations is the next natural step for us and the residents,” said Brian Key, BRWA Executive Director. “We look forward to offering the Montvale Water customers the same level of services that we provide the rest of Bedford County.”
